**Veteran Dog or Bitch (7: 4 absent)**

1. Taylor's Hillplace Golly

Nearly 11 year old brindle/white bitch in absolutely fantastic condition. Very well constructed, correct topline, good width and depth of chest with true tacked on shoulders. Her eyes were clear and bright, small ears correctly placed, good underjaw and open nostrils. She moved soundly without any sign of stiffness. What an amazing bitch and a credit to this kennel.

2. White's Quintic Dora at Purebully

8 year old brindle/white bitch. Again her condition belied her age. Good width of chest, just lacking the depth of (1). She had a good brick shaped head with lovely clear dark eyes, a good mouth and nice ears. Moved well.

3. McCafferty & Wales' Tagdalee Teddy Boy of Beldoon

**Minor Puppy Dog (3)**

1. Stutter's Erimusbulls Cooper at Linmist

6 month old red/white puppy. He is obviously very immature, but looking at him you can see how he will finish – everything is in place as it should be. Good front with sufficient width for his age, balanced with correct depth of chest. Tacked on shoulders with straight front legs leading to tidy feet. One of the best mouths of the day, very good underjaw, flat skull, lovely dark clear eyes and open nostrils. Correct topline, finished with good tail and rear angulation. Moved soundly. **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW**

2. Davies' Baalzebull Apache Tears

6 month old red/white puppy. Very different type to (1) and although promising, he needs much more time to mature. Very good bone, shoulders and width of chest. Already very deep chest. Good topline, correct pear shaped body and rear angulation. Beautiful underjaw and lovely dark clear eyes.

3. Meakin's Erimusbulls British Steel for Meakabull

**Puppy Dog (2)**

1. Phillips' Rokoluck Mr Cracker

9-month old red/white puppy that I have admired from the ringside. Very good mover front and rear – completely walks his width. Good bone with correct feet, straight front, good width of chest, would like slightly more depth of chest just to finish the picture, but at his age this could well come. Brick shaped head with good mouth, clear dark eyes and correctly placed neat ears.

2. Davies' Kismond Icelandic Sunset

11-month old brindle/white puppy. Very good head with super underjaw and sour expression. Dark eyes and small correctly placed ears. Straight front and good feet. Unsettled on the move - he moves a lot better when moved slowly. This puppy is improving all the time.

**Junior Dog (6: 1 absent)**

1. Ives' Ivabully Independence

15-month old red/white dog. My first comment on my recorder about this dog is "what a stunner". This is a good honest bulldog with super bone, straight front, plenty of width and depth of chest with good tacked on shoulders. Very good spring of ribs giving correct pear shape body. Super head with flat skull, dark eyes and small well placed ears. Sour expression with good mouth and upturn of jaw. To finish it off he has a good tail and moved very well. RESERVE BEST DOG.

2. Dearlove's Lumbuse Mr Douglas Home for Ryjarlow

14-month old red/white dog. I have long admired this dog from the ringside and he did not disappoint. Well constructed, good bone with width and depth of chest. Very good mover, walked his width, good topline finished with a good tail. Dark eye and good mouth, I prefer the expression of (1), but there is still time for his head to finish.

3. Papworth's Terralynda I get Around

**Novice Dog (4: 3 absent)**

1. Davies' Kismond Icelandic Sunset

**Postgraduate Dog (2: 1 absent)**

1. Anscombe's Greenawell Mr Bumble

2-year old red/white dog with a good head and lovely upturn. Straight front with good bone and tacked on shoulders, nicely angulated rear, topped off by a good tail. His good construction was reflected in his good movement. Ideally I would like more depth of chest.

**Limit Dog (4)**

1. Davies' Baalzebull Rawks

2-year old red/white dog with super bone, good barrel ribs, beautiful forechest leading to good feet. Real male head, balanced in width and depth of skull with great upturn, dark eye and correctly placed small ears. Good neck and shoulders, moved well.

2. Taylor's Hillplace Captain Hook

2-year old brindle/white dog with completely balanced construction. Correct topline and good shoulders, lovely head and expression with flat skull and small correctly placed ears, finished with clear dark eyes and a good mouth. He moved very well.

3. Anscombe's Greenawell Mr Bumble

**Open Dog (4: 1 absent)**

1. Taylor's Hillplace Rufio

2-year old brindle/white dog with fantastic balanced construction - just filled the eye and even better to go over. Balanced body with correct topline, lovely shoulders and neck, good width of chest and

sufficient depth, very good bone, super straight front leading to neat padded feet. Lovely head and expression with very good upturn and good mouth, clear dark eyes and small ears. Moved very well. BEST DOG and BEST IN SHOW

2. Davies Baalzebull Chianti

3-year old white dog of smaller type than (1) but still very well constructed with good forechest, straight front, correct topline and good rear angulation, finished off with a good tail. Moved well and very well handled

3. Davies' Kerkade Show Time with Kismond

**Special Beginners Dog (4)**

1. Papworth's Terralynda I Get Around

14-month old red/white dog with a good straight front with nice bone, and a good neck and shoulders, nice rear angulation topped off with a good tail. Very mature head with good mouth, but he still needs to finish in body - he's a big boy so time is definitely on his side.

2. Meakin's Erimusbulls British Steel for Meakabull

6-month old red/white puppy with a lot of potential. Litter brother to Best Puppy but so much more immature. He has superb bone, beautiful straight front with plenty of width and depth, lovely body with correct topline and a good tail. His head is very overwrinkled at the moment, and doesn't fit his body, but with maturity I think he could finish a really good one. Just give him time

3. Anscombe's Greenawell Mr Bumble

**Minor Puppy Bitch (8: 3 absent)**

1. Thorpe's Robobull Tatum

6-month old brindle/white. A good honest bulldog, correct pear shaped body, very balanced with good width and depth of chest, straight front legs, nice shoulders, lovely topline and good tail. Good upturn of jaw with lovely dark eyes. Very nice puppy.

2. Weller's Baazebull Diamond Clarity for Greenawell

6-month old red/white. Another nice puppy, good bone, straight front leading to neat feet. Nice shoulders and good neck. Attractive and balanced head and good expression. I preferred the topline and tail of (1).

3. Davies' Baalzebull Snowflake Onyx

**Puppy Bitch (5: 2 absent)**

1. Davies' Kismond Winter Sunset

11-month old brindle/white. Beautiful true brick shaped head with wonderful upturn of jaw, dark eyes, flat skull and small correctly placed ears. Good bone, very good front with both width and depth. Good tail and rear angulation. Moved very well, walked her width.

2. Davies' Baalzebull Venus

11-month old red/white. Very promising puppy, not so mature as (1) and head needs to finish, but time is on her side, and everything else is there. She has a straight front, good bone and width and depth of forechest. She moved well walked her width. Just needs time to mature.

### 3. Hughes and Newman's Rokoluck Candy Cane

#### **Junior Bitch (10: 3 absent)**

##### 1. Weller's Baalzebul Constance for Greenawell

15-month old white bitch. She is a completely balanced feminine bitch with a lovely head, superb mouth, very good upturn of jaw and lovely dark eyes. She has good front with both width and depth of chest, straight bone leading to good feet. Her profile is very good, she has adequate rear angulation, good topline, shoulders and neck, finished with a good tail. An all over quality bitch, free from any exaggeration. BEST BITCH IN SHOW and RESERVE BEST IN SHOW

##### 2. Davies' Baalzebul Kir Royale

13-month old brindle/white. Smaller bitch than (1) but still a quality bitch. Good shoulders and front, lovely head with great upturn of jaw and dark eyes. Good topline and tail. She moved very well and walked her width.

##### 3. Pinkowska's Liebre Monica Give me a Kiss

#### **Novice Bitch (7: 4 absent)**

##### 1. Davies' Kismond Winter Sunset

##### 2. Dauphin-Simmons' Senidan Queen of Hearts

18-month old red/white. Good front, lovely tacked on shoulders, good flat skull with length and depth and good upturn of jaw, good barrel rib and lovely tail. Moved very well.

##### 3. Russell's Bagibeli Fleur at Unijax

#### **Post Graduate Bitch (10: 6 absent)**

##### 1. Stephenson's Odinschild Norse Sunrise

Red/white bitch with lovely front and straight bone down to neat feet, complete with correct depth of chest. Good typical head with wide balanced muzzle and lovely underjaw, clear dark eyes and small neat ears. Correct topline with good tail, nice neck leading into correctly tacked on shoulders which meant she walked her width. Very competently and sympathetically handled by her young handler.

##### 2. Davis' Kentixen Fancy Florin at Tanglemede

Red/white bitch with beautiful head, lovely chin, good upturn, clear dark eyes topped off with good ears. Good width of chest and straight front legs. Handler tended to stand her too wide so she lost some depth of chest. Completely balanced construction with good topline and lovely tail. Another one who moved well and walked her width.

##### 3. White's Hillplace Little Maid for Purebully

#### **Limit Bitch (5)**

##### 1. White's Purebully Never Forget

Well constructed white/brindle bitch with good bone and a lovely front. Very good shoulders, good neck, well sprung ribs and good topline with correct rise. A very fit bitch who moved really well and walked her width.

She would look better in the ring if she carried more weight. Lovely head with good underjaw, wide balanced muzzle, good mouth, flat skull and correctly placed small ears. RESERVE BEST BITCH

2. Weller's Rokoluck Dolly Rocker for Greenawell

Fawn/white bitch with a good head and lovely sour expression. She has good width of chest, and the placing could have been reversed if she'd had slightly more depth. She's a very sound bitch with a good topline and moved really well.

3. Welsh and Powell's Slaughden Born to Sea at Slimjacq

**Open Bitch (4: 2 absent)**

A difficult class because both bitches were lame, but the handlers chose to stay and be judged

1. Dauphin-Simmons' Senidan Deja Vue

Lovely red/white bitch with good bone, straight front, good depth of chest and superb shoulders. Very well constructed with definite pear shape body and good hindquarters. Beautiful head with sour expression and superb upturn of jaw. It was a great pity she was unsound behind when she moved – the owner felt she was stiff as she'd just got out of her crate.

2. Russell's Brandoux Florence for Unijax

6-year old red/white bitch with a nice head, dark eyes and good topline. She was not so good in front as (1), but has good shoulders and neck. When she moved she was unsound on her left foreleg.
